

Call for Proposals:

Hausdorff Trimester Programs

The idea behind a Hausdorff Trimester Program is to bring together a group of mathematicians and/or economists from the international community to carry out research at the Hausdorff Research Institute for Mathematics (HIM), with a primary emphasis on collaborative activities. The Institute can host up to 30 scientists at any one time. Ideally, a mix of senior scientists, post-docs, and PhD students are invited to each program. The stays are fully financed by the Institute, depending on approval of new funding. The theme of each program is open to suggestion via proposals from groups of leading scientists. The overall topic can come from all areas of mathematics, mathematical economics, and mathematical physics. Three time slots are available (whereby the exact start and finish dates are pending): September to December 2019, January to April 2020, and May to August 2020.
